Instructions for the 2019-2020 Scholarship Application

Deadline for submission: MARCH 31, 2019

Step 1: Eligibility

In order to be eligible to apply, the prospective applicant should meet the following criteria:

- Applicant must be a RCHS Senior
- Applicant must be in the top 10% of their class
- Must have been accepted or pending acceptance to a CSU, UC, or community college in California

Step 2: Complete Application Packet

A complete COED scholarship application packet should have the following:

- Completed application form
- Resume detailing academic honors, volunteer experience, and other extracurricular activities (Part 4 of application form)
- Completed essays (Part 5 of application form)
- 2 Letters of Recommendation (*one must be from a faculty member of RCHS*)
- Official high school academic transcript (*must include class percentile ranking*)

*Incomplete applications at the time of the submission deadline will not be considered.
