Instructions for the 2021-2022 Application

Deadline for submission: May 31, 2021

Step 1: Eligibility

In order to be eligible to apply, the prospective applicant should meet the following criteria:

- Applicant must be a high school graduate of any public high school in the Sacramento and Yolo County
- In the top 10% of current class
- Must have been accepted or pending acceptance to a CSU, UC or community college in California

Step 2: Complete Application Packet

A complete COED Fellowship application packet should have the following:

- Completed application form
- Document detailing academic honors, volunteer experience, and other extracurricular activities (Part 4 of application form)
- Completed essays (Part 5 of Application Form)
- 2 Letters of Recommendation (one must be from a faculty member)
- Official high school academic transcript (must include class percentile ranking)

Please make sure your application packet is complete. Incomplete applications at the time of the submission deadline will not be considered.

Step 3: Submit Application Packet
